PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF WEEDS IN INDUSTRIAL AREAS, NON-CROP SITUATIONS, ROADSIDES, RAIL CORRIDORS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY

PERMIT NUMBER – PER88677

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Employees of, or persons acting under the direction of the permit holder, GTE Track Spray Pty Ltd, who are trained and experienced in the use of agricultural chemicals.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

CAVALIER 500 SC HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 81077) Containing: 500 g/L OXYFLUORFEN as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINTS:

DO NOT apply by spray equipment carried on the back of the user.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Target Weed	Rate
Industrial areas, non-crop situations, roadside, rail corridors and rights-of-way.	Weeds listed on the product label	1.5-1.9 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Use in accordance with the product label.
- Apply a maximum of 1 application per season.
- DO NOT apply less than 6 months after the initial treatment.
- DO NOT allow entry into treated areas until the spray has dried, unless wearing cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist (or equivalent clothing) and chemical resistant gloves. Clothing must be laundered after each day of use.
- Comply with 'Protections' statements on the product label.

Withholding Period:

Grazing: DO NOT allow livestock to graze treated weeds.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
