**AGRONOMIC USE**

**MODE OF ACTION: MIRADOR 25 SC** is a fungicide with protectant, curative, eradicator, translaminar and systemic properties. Inhibits spore germination and mycelial growth, and also shows antispore activity.

**APPLICATION EQUIPMENT: MIRADOR 25 SC** can be used with any conventional spray equipment. Before using make sure all application equipment and nozzles are properly calibrated and are in good working condition and without leaks. In terrestrial applications use a mixture volume of 200 L/ha and on aerial sprays use a volume of 50-80 L/ha. Use hollow cone spray nozzles.



**HOW TO PREPARE THE MIXTURE:** Fill the tank with water until half full then pour in the required dosage of **MIRADOR 25 SC**, complete the filling of the tank with water and stir the solution. The mixture should be used on the same day of preparation. Persons mixing and washing the equipment should wear the following protective gears; gloves, mask or respirators, goggles and rubber boots.

**APPLICATION INTERVAL:** Spaced 8-day applications.

**PREHARVEST INTERVAL:** Rice and banana 0 days. Tomato 7 days. Melon: 7-10 days.

**INTERVAL FOR REENTRY INTO TREATED AREAS:** 24 hours or when the product has totally dried out.

**PHYTOTOXICITY:** Not phytotoxic at recommended doses.

**COMPATIBILITY:** Compatible with most products.

**STORAGE AND TRANSPORT:** Do not store or transport along with foodstuff, cooking utensils, and other household items.
