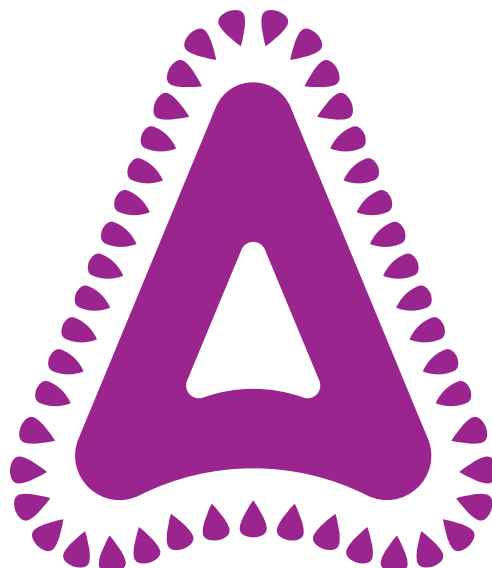

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN ALL STATES

RESTRAINTS

DO NOT exceed 3 m between bait stations for mice, or 9 m for rats. DO NOT place bait station in open.

Baiting strategy

Eliminate as far as practicable, all alternative food sources.

Bait infested area. Place ready to use bait in small containers (bait stations). Mice require several bait stations, 50 g per station (less than 1 g will kill a mouse). Rats require large quantities of bait in one or two locations, 50-100 g per station (4 - 6 g will kill a rat). For effective control continue to bait until feeding ceases.

Place bait stations under cover. Inspect bait stations daily. Replace eaten baits. If eaten quickly increase number of bait stations. Continue observation and replenishment until no more baits are taken. Baiting for at least two weeks is necessary to reduce rat/ mouse numbers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Pellets are not subject to wind dispersal. Most deaths occur 4 to 7 days after consumption of bait. Locate bait stations along walls or rafters and in dark, sheltered spots where there are signs of rodent activity. Record the number of locations of bait stations for purpose of replenishment and later removal.

PRECAUTION

The bait is hazardous to pigs, cats, dogs, poultry, birds and wildlife and care should be exercised in its use. DO NOT place baits in locations which are accessible to domestic animals, livestock or birds.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the bait or used containers. Look for dead rats or mice – burn or bury them. DO NOT place in refuse bins or rubbish tips. Inspect all bait stations regularly and ensure baits are removed when rodent activity has ceased. The product is restricted to use in and around buildings (within 2 metres) or enclosed spaces, eg. drains.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Containers which have held bait should not be used for any other purpose. Store in original containers, tightly closed, in a safe place. Dispose of empty containers and unused or untaken bait by burying in an approved landfill.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Poisonous if swallowed. DO NOT inhale dust. DO NOT touch bait. Use scoop or measure. If on skin, and after each baiting, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Vitamin K₁ (Phytomenadione) is antidotal.

FIRST AID

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre. Phone Australia 131126.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Brodifacoum is a long-lasting anticoagulant chemical. Vitamin K₁ (Phytomenadione) should be administered urgently by medical or appropriate para-medical personnel. If administered intravenously the injection must be given slowly. The active constituent of Rodex B Pellets is an anticoagulant chemical, which if accidentally taken by humans, domestic animals or pets, can reduce the clotting power of the blood and haemorrhage may result.
