



## **Voluntary Recall of ADAMA GIBBERELIC ACID 1L (Batch No. 47853/1)**

**13<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

ADAMA Australia has recently been made aware of an issue relating to a small number of drums labelled as part of a batch of ADAMA GIBBERELIC ACID 1L. In consultation with the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority, ADAMA Australia has commenced a voluntary recall of the following batch:

ADAMA GIBBERELIC ACID 1L (Containing: 100g/L Gibberellic Acid)

Batch No: 47853/1

Date of Manufacture: October 2017

ADAMA Australia has made contact with all affected distributors and all known affected growers and is undertaking a voluntary recall on the entire batch as a precautionary measure.

This voluntary recall is being conducted due to the wrong product being added to some 1L containers labelled as Gibberellic Acid. This incorrect product is phytotoxic to some target species.

People in possession of the affected batch should discontinue use and return product to ADAMA Australia or to the place of purchase.

ADAMA Australia is undertaking a full investigation and will be working closely with resellers, growers and industry to understand the impact to crops and what corrective action is required.
