EQUIPMENT

Use well calibrated broadcast or band spreaders.

STORAGE

PRODUCT INFORMATION

Ferrabait® is a ready to use bait for the control of slugs and snails, and reduction of feeding damage, in a wide range of arable, horticultural and ornamental crops. It controls all significant pest slug and snail species.

Ferrabait® uses pharmaceutical grade ingredients that kill slugs and snails by interfering with oxygen uptake, leading to cessation of feeding and movement and death. Death may take some time to occur following ingestion.

Ferrabait® is highly crop safe and may be applied at any crop growth stage, but should be applied prior to or at the first sign of slugs and snails, and before crop damage is evident.

The bait has a high degree of rainfastness and mould resistance. However, repeat applications may be necessary due to consumption or weathering, particularly under high pest pressure and rainfall conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TAKE ALL REASONABLE STEPS TO ENSURE THAT THE SUBSTANCE DOES NOT CAUSE ANY SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE EFFECTS TO THE ENVIRONMENT BEYOND THE APPLICATION AREA.

By law, the product must not be used on animals unless the use is approved as part of this registration.

EPA CONTROLS

- Apply using ground-based methods only;
- A person who handles this substance must wear gloves; and
- Maximum application rate: 8 kg/ha.

Apply when refuge traps indicate slug or snail presence, or when conditions favour their activity (mild, damp weather). Use the higher rate when slug pressure is high.

CROP	RATE	CRITICAL COMMENTS
Arable crops Direct sown	6-8kg/ha	Broadcast evenly over the soil surface, or as a band over the row, at or immediately after drilling/transplanting. Repeat applications as necessary.
Horticultural crops Transplanted and direct sown	6-8kg/ha	Broadcast evenly over the soil surface, or as a band over the row, at or immediately after drilling/transplanting or during periods when crops are likely to be affected by slugs and snails. Repeat applications as necessary.
Ornamental crops Transplanted and direct sown	6-8kg/ha 60-80g/100m ²	Broadcast evenly over the soil surface, or as a band over the row, at or immediately after drilling/transplanting or during periods when crops are likely to be affected by slugs and snails. Repeat applications as necessary.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS: Not required when used as directed.



Avoid grazing treated areas until baits have broken down.

Avoid applying to horticultural crops close to harvest as presence of baits is unacceptable to consumers.

EQUIPMENT

Apply Ferrabait® with well calibrated broadcast or band spreaders to ensure even bait coverage over the area to be treated. For small areas hand spreading can be effective.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

No group code exists. Ferrabait® contains elemental iron that interferes with oxygen uptake leading to cessation of feeding and movement. Resistance development is unlikely. However, use of cultural control practices such as removal or burial of trash and avoidance of sowing susceptible crops into known high pressure areas, as part of an integrated management approach is recommended.
