Pump large amounts of liquid into a salvage container, then absorb remaining free liquid with clay granules, sawdust or sand. Wash down affected area with water plus alkaline detergent and absorb washings. Dispose of all contaminated materials in an authorised waste collection point or bury in an approved landfill.											
Fire	Call the fire Service: Dial 111. Fire decomposition products may be toxic if inhaled. Total protection required including contained breathing apparatus in enclosed areas or in close proximity to fire. Extinguishing media: Use extinguishing media suited to burning materials.
