## **STORAGE**

CITADEL FUNGICIDE has both contact and systemic action. It is absorbed by leaves and stems and translocated in an upward and outward movement in the plant to provide some protection to new growth.

Wheat	Stripe rust, leaf rust, powdery mildew, speckled leaf blotch	
Onions	White rot	Use 1.5 L in 1000 L of water/ha. Apply 6-8 weeks after planting, then 2 further applications at 3-4 week intervals. The use of a suitable seed treatment is recommended.
Peas	Powdery mildew	Use 250 mL/ha and apply at first appearance of disease. Repeat 14 days later if disease persists.

#### COMPATIBILITY

Compatible with most commonly used fungicides and insecticides.

#### **APPLICATION**

For cereals, ryegrass and peas apply in at least 200 L of water/ha by ground application or 50 L/ha by aerial application. Use higher water volumes in dense or advanced crops especially under dry weather conditions. For onions apply 1000 L of water/ha.

#### **RAINFALL**

Rain falling within 1 hour following treatment may reduce effectiveness.

#### RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

CITADEL FUNGICIDE contains the GROUP 3 DMI fungicide, triadimenol. Do not use another product containing a fungicide in the same group in conjunction with CITADEL FUNGICIDE. Adhere to recommendations for application rate, timing and the maximum numbers of applications in the directions for use. Exceeding the maximum number of applications per season will increase the risk of resistance development. Wherever practical, apply CITADEL FUNGICIDE in mixture with an effective dose of a fungicide from a different cross-resistance group. Apply CITADEL FUNGICIDE preventatively when disease levels are low, but disease risk is high. Where this product is used to control more than one pathogen in a crop the maximum numbers of applications allowed per season, apply to the whole crop, not to each individual disease.

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
