### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It should be used as part of a season long foliar program and should also be applied before and after periods of stress such as drought, low temperatures, excess rain etc. It is designed to be absorbed by the plant foliage and will not burn or scorch plant growth when applied at recommended rates.
