## SECTION 4: First aid measures

### 4.1. Description of first aid measures

First-aid measures general : In all cases of doubt, or when symptoms persist, seek medical attention.  
 First-aid measures after inhalation : Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If experiencing respiratory symptoms: Call a poison center or a doctor.  
 First-aid measures after skin contact : Remove all contaminated clothing and footwear. Wash with plenty of water. In case of redness or irritation, call a doctor.  
 First-aid measures after eye contact : Rinse immediately and thoroughly, pulling the eyelids well away from the eye (15 minutes minimum). Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Consult an eye specialist immediately, even if there are no immediate symptoms.  
 First-aid measures after ingestion : Rinse mouth out with water. If the person is fully conscious, make him/her drink plenty of water. Never give an unconscious person anything to drink. Immediately consult a doctor/medical service.

### 4.2. Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

Symptoms/effects after inhalation : Corrosive to the respiratory tract.
