SOIL TYPE GUIDANCE

The following should be used as guide to interpret SHOTPUT® label guidance with respect to soil type restrictions (DO NOT treat sands):

Potato and soil type	Maximum individual dose	Maximum total dose	Latest time of application
Earlies (first and second) Very light and light soils, medium and heavy soils, peat and organic soils	0.75 kg/ha	0.75 kg/ha per crop	Pre- emergence
Maincrop* Very light and light soils, medium, heavy, peat and organic soils	0.75 kg/ha pre- emergence AND/OR 0.5 kg/ha post-emergence	1.25 kg/ha per crop (maximum 0.5kg/ha applied post-em)	Before the shoots of potatoes reach 15cm in length

*low dose method all soil types

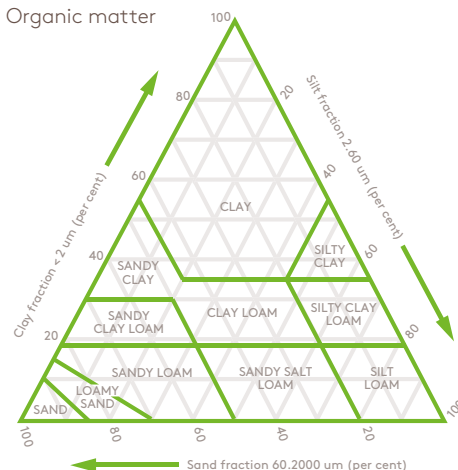
Plot your sand, silt and clay % onto adjacent texture triangle to determine the texture of your soils. Soil textures classes can be prefixed as organic or peaty depending on organic matter levels.

Organic soils – typically 6 – 10% Organic matter.

Peaty soils – 20 – 25% Organic matter

Peat Soils – > 35% Organic matter
