
Grower Guide 2021

As part of the Double Team[™] Sorghum Cropping Solution, FirstAct[™] herbicide delivers sorghum growers reliable broad spectrum grass control along with flexible rotation and high yields for more profitable returns per acre.

- 1. Stewardship requires that a Double Team[™] sorghum hybrid be sprayed with FirstAct[™] herbicide
- 2. Plant into a clean field by either spraying or tillage
- 3. Growers are required to use a preemergent herbicide:
 - a. Required: Apply at least a half-rate of grass control product such as Parallel[®], Parallel[®]
 Plus, or others with Al's of dimethenamid-P, or acetochlor (refer to label for specific instructions)
 - Recommended: A full rate of a grass control product + a broadleaf herbicide such as atrazine, saflufenacil, or mesotrione
 - i. The use of tank mixes with atrazine help with grass control when utilized as a preemergent.
 - ii. The addition of saflufenacil and or mesotrione help with broadleaf control and resistance management of broadleaf weeds.

- 4. No postemergence tank mixes with FirstAct will be allowed during the 2021 growing season
 - a. It is recommended that an over the top broadleaf herbicide application (if required) be made at least a week prior to FirstAct application.

5. Apply FirstAct to Double Team sorghum when sorghum is at the 8-leaf stage or later

- FirstAct rates will depend on grass species and size. Always read and follow the herbicide label
 - **a.** Most rates will be 8-10 oz./acre.
 - b. Difficult-to-control perennial weeds will require a use rate of 12 oz./acre.
 - c. Apply with COC at 1% v/v with a minimum spray volume of 15 GPA.
 - **d.** Two applications are allowed with maximum rate of 21 oz/acre/year.
 - e. The last application must be made at least 45 days prior to harvest.

7. A signed grower agreement is required to buy and plant Double Team sorghum

- **a.** If seed is not planted, it must be returned to Sorghum Partners or destroyed.
- **b.** It cannot be shared with another producer.
- 8. Clean out your planter before and after planting Double Team sorghum
 - a. Non-DT sorghum in your Double Team fields will result in plant death.



- **b.** Cleaning out after planting Double Team sorghum will improve stewardship efforts.
- 9. In 2021, grain from the Double Team system must be kept out of the commodity grain channel
 - **a.** End uses include animal feeding, ethanol production, or industrial uses.
 - **b.** If you have questions or need help with channeling your grain, contact your Sorghum Partners representative.
