PRECAUTION/HAZARD MEASURES:

Harmful to fish-do not contaminate water bodies. Avoid inhaling spray mist. Always wear protective clothing when handling concentrated product. Wash with soap and water after use and in the event of skin contact. In case of eye contact rinse eyes with clean running water for at least 15-20 minutes. Wash contaminated clothing after use. APPLICATION AND TIMING

MAIZINE 30 OD can be applied by any suitable ground applicator such as knapsack and tractor mounted sprayers, provided it is equipped with an efficient agitation mechanism. Use flat fan nozzles. Use at least 200 L spray mixture/ha to obtain complete coverage of weeds. Avoid spraying weeds and crops under stress conditions such as drought and water logging. Apply MAIZINE 30 OD two weeks after crop has emerged and established and weeds are at 2-5 leaves stage.

Application instructions:

Use this product when the maize crop is at 2-5 leaves stage and weeds are also at 2-5 leaves stage of growth. Preferably, two (2) weeks after the emergence of the crop. Use the product once each season. Do not use this product if there will be wind or rains within an hour.
